The MCALEER/PIERCE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP is dedicated to the memory of our dear friends, Joan & Jay McAleer and Virginia & Tom Pierce, all of whom were devoted to helping veterans with spinal cord injury and other individuals with physical disabilities.

Our Auxiliary is associated with veterans who have a spinal cord injury or disease. Our interest, however, is not limited to veterans with disabilities. This scholarship is intended for a graduating high school student who is planning to attend a college or university. The student must have a permanent physical disability or have a parent(s) with a permanent physical disability. The amount of this non-renewable scholarship is \$500.00.

Interested students who meet the above qualifications are asked to complete a *College Funding Estimator* worksheet. You can locate the worksheet online at www.educationquest.org. Click on *College Funding Estimator* in the list on the bottom right and then click on College Funding Estimator 2020 – 2021. Answer the questions provided and print out the results. In addition, students are required to submit a 250-word essay that provides a brief description of the permanent physical disability situation, a synopsis of the student's high school activities and plans for their future education. The application, 250-word essay, and funding estimator results must be submitted by March 1, 2020 and sent to the address indicated in the letterhead.

Selected recipients will be notified by April 1, 2020 and the scholarship check will be presented at a special awards reception. We will let the student know the exact date of the reception when it becomes available.
