In addition, students are required to submit a 250-word essay that provides a brief description of the permanent physical disability situation, a synopsis of the student's high school activities, and plans for their future education. The application, 250-word essay, and funding estimator results must be submitted by March 1, 2022 and sent to the address indicated in the letterhead.

The selected recipient(s) will be notified by April 1, 2022 and details will be determined closer to that time regarding presentation of the scholarship.
